#### SPECIAL ELECTING CONVENTION EPISCOPAL DIOCESE OF WESTERN KANSAS ST. MICHAELS CHURCH, HAYS KS SATURDAY, MAY 5, 2018

Bishop Milliken gaveled the Convention to order at 10:40 a.m. and asked The Rev. Don Martin to offer opening prayers.

Following opening prayers, Bishop introduced Convention Secretary Toni Cottrell and explained that due to Sherry Dentons illness and inability to be with us, Linda Boone would serve as Assistant Secretary for this meeting. Bishop also introduced Pam Smith, Salina; Sally Russell, Hutchinson; Mike Rees, Dodge City and Linda Boone, Hays as tellers; Parliamentarian was appointed by the Bishop to serve for this Special Convention; Mark Kliewer, Garden City.

Secretary Cottrell began roll call of clergy and lay delegates to establish quorums in each house for the election of the 6<sup>th</sup> Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Western Kansas. Following roll call of both orders, there were 29 clergy present and 55 lay delegates present to vote. Simple majority in both orders is required for an election. For this election, it will take 15 votes in the clergy order and 28 votes in the lay order to elect.

Bishop explained the balloting procedures; when you receive your ballot, place the number 1 in the upper right corner before you vote, then send your completed ballot to the end of the row where the tellers will pick up the ballots.

The first ballot was cast, tellers picked up the ballots and went to the Parish Hall to count votes.

The election of the 6<sup>th</sup> Bishop of Diocese of Western Kansas, The Rev. Mark A. Cowell, occurred on the first ballot:

#### Minutes of the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention Episcopal Diocese of Western Kansas Salina, Kansas October 19, 20, 2018

#### Friday morning, October 19, 2018 Opening Eucharist

The Convention Eucharist began our annual gathering at 10 AM in Christ Cathedral with The Rt. Rev. Michael P. Milliken as celebrant and preacher. The Necrology report was read during Prayers of the People and a complete list is included in these minutes. At the Offertory, the United Thank Offering in gathering was presented by representatives from each of the congregations without this diocese.

Delegates, clergy and visitors had lunch in Salina, on their own following the Eucharist, and convention convened at 2 PM at the Salina Country Club.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Business Session

First report of Dispatch of Business was adopted, Special Orders of Business were adopted. Convention delegates, clergy, alternate delegates, youth and guests were welcomed to Salina and the 48<sup>th</sup> Diocesan Convention by The Very Rev. David Hodges, Dean of Christ Cathedral.

Bishop Milliken announced the appointment of The Rev. Amy Long as Parliamentarian, Toni Cottrell as Convention Secretary and Linda Boone as Assistant Secretary of Convention. Bishop also announced the ECW baskets to be presented at the banquet are in the display area and you may look them over and purchase tickets for the drawing for said baskets. Bishop Milliken then introduced The Rev. Shay Craig, Diocese of Chicago, as curate of Christ Church Cathedral.

#### **Budget and Finance Report**

Dr. Mike Wamsley, Chairman, recognized all members of the committee for their diligent work; Carolyn Peterson, Toni Cottrell, Pam Smith, The Rev. Michael Milliken and Chairman Wamsley. He then made the first presentation of the 2019 budget. Dr. Wamsley explained the various changes in the 2019 budget, primarily those affecting the new Bishop and his expenses. Discussion and vote will take place during Saturday's business session. At this time Bishop Milliken spoke about two beloved members of the church in Western Kansas who have died recently; Sherry Denton from Incarnation in Salina, and The Rev. Georgia Decker, Deacon of the church, Hutchinson. Both women had very active ministries in this diocese for many years. Sherry represented her diocese at several General Conventions, served on many committees at the national level, was an officer for Province VII as well, and was on the Board of Directors for Seminary of the Southwest in Austin for at least two terms. She served on Executive Council at the national level and was active in the Cursillo movement in our diocese and belonged to a reunion group at Incarnation which formed after she and her husband went to Cursillo in the 1980s. Deacon Decker passed away, even though she wasn't quite ready. No one I know epitomized the meaning of Deacon of

the Church more than Georgia did. Also, if some of you have been around the church in Western Kansas for a while, you may remember The Rev. Tom Keith who along with The Rev. Konrad Rock served the church in the Central Region for several years took care of five churches, he also taught at Sterling College and mentored several of our current clergy as they studied toward ordination. Rev. Tom passed away this past summer, and his beloved wife Adelaide died about six months before Tom, and after that, he just gave up.

#### **Credentials Committee**

The Rev. Karen Lemon, Chair of Credentials announced the count for this business session of convention: Clergy 26 of 36 are certified; Laity - 46 of 57.

#### **Nominations Committee**

The Rev. Dennis Gilhousen, chair of the committee reported all nominees to various committee openings will be elected during Saturday's business session with two exceptions: Standing Committee has only one nomination in the clerical order and one nomination in the lay order. Chair requested Convention Secretary cast a unanimous ballot for those two nominees and they were elected. Commission on Ministry had two openings, one for clergy and one for laity. There were two nominees, one for clergy and one for laity and Chair requested Convention Secretary cast a unanimous ballot for the two nominees and they were elected. There were not enough nominees for any of the openings to require ballots for election. Further, the elections for Diocesan Council will be held on Saturday morning. Normally we have the election of two clergy for a three-year term and two lay people for a threeyear term. This year we have elections for two clergy for three-year term; one clergy for two-year term for The Rev. Georgia Decker, to fill her chair, not to take her place; and two clergy for one year terms because our new Bishop-Elect cannot serve as a member of Council since he is the Bishop, and one clergy, The Rev. Laird MacGregor is resigning and moving to the Diocese of Kansas. Therefore, we do have five (5) nominations to fill those five positions: The Rev. Shay Craig, The Rev. Jerry Jones, The Rev. Basil Price, The Rev. Randy McIntosh and the Rev. John Seatvet. The five (5) clergy drew straws - sort of, and The Rev. Shay Craig and The Rev. John Seatvet got the three year terms; The Rev. Jerry Jones got the two- year term, and The Rev. Basil Price and The Rev. Randy McIntosh each have one year terms on Council In the lay order tor Diocesan Council, there were two nominees, both from Salina; Kathleen Crouch and Pam Smith. The Chair requested Convention Secretary cast a unanimous ballot for the two nominees, and they were elected to serve three-year terms.

Diocesan Council and Standing Committees will meet on December 8, 2018.

Bishop Milliken reported two clergy are leaving this diocese; The Rev. Terry Dekoran has gone to the Diocese of West Missouri and The Rev. Laird MacGregor has moved to Lawrence, in the Diocese of Kansas.

Jimmy Lemon is involved in a program called Walking With Jimmy. He was introduced and spoke about the program which began in 2016. Bringing family members back together, those who have been ill and those who have cared for them or have been estranged for one reason or another. The WWJ program began in Spain as a ministry to work to reunite the family units with counselors, sociologists, and medical professionals as needed, as well as going to a new environment for the entire group to get a new perspective on life. There are several

components to the program, one being the therapeutic aspect where we put the family in a new, exciting environment where the members receive additional support and encouragement. We have taken a family to the pacific northwest for hiking in the rain forest, biking and whale watching, sailing and exploring the family dynamic. Tying this all together and supporting the family dynamic is the goal for these families in the program. Funding for this has been easier and more positive than anticipated with more donations coming in electronically as well as through the mail. Our internet presence and individual key sponsors as well as Washington State Park Rangers, the boat owners who took us whale watching, those who made it possible to hike in the rain forest have all helped with their greatly discounted rates for our group. A short power point presentation followed. If you are interested in contributing funds, send your check to All Saints Episcopal Church in Pratt, KS, marked Walking With Jimmy.

#### **Project Resource**

Bishop Milliken explained briefly that Project Resource is a program in the Episcopal Church worthy of our participation. Bishop Milliken, Bishop-Elect Cowell, Toni Cottrell, The Rev. Ted Blakley, The Rev. Shay Craig and DeMay Grunden attended the presentation in April of this year at Camp Allen in the diocese of Texas. We will have three separate presentations from the part of Project Resource which deals with Stewardship and Fund Raising. The Rev. Ted Blakley will speak this afternoon on "What Is Our Why", tonight at dinner The Rt. Rev. Clay Matthews will speak on a personal story and then tomorrow morning DeMay Grunden will speak on "Scarcity To Abundance." Within the diocese we will need a capital campaign soon, not to raise funds to run the diocese but funds to endow two full time resident clergy, one in the southwest and one in the northwest. We must remember Father Don Martin, Mother Carolyn Ballinger, Mother Rita Stockton and Father John Seatvet all are aging out and will need help, relief, replacement in time to come.

Father Blakley spoke about What Is Our Why? He presented a short video by Simon Sinek, entitled "Start With Why" which is where to begin with a stewardship campaign since it usually goes Why, How, What. "Fundraising is a ministry, it is not a response to crisis. Money is an issue; hold the check and listen to the response; offer others opportunity to participate is vision and ministry." Henri Nouwen.

We adjourned at 5:00 pm. Social hour and dinner will begin at 6:30 pm.

As we gathered for congenial libations and a good meal, we also were blessed with a second part of the Project Resource entitled Abstract Thought, presented by The Rt. Rev. Clayton Matthews, who was our guest for the Convention dinner. Bishop Matthews spoke about the US being very well off and comfortable compared to much of the world - food, shelter and clothing. We don't want for much. Generosity is a journey; unique but very much alike. One person's act of generosity can make such a difference. Bishop Milliken then presented the Bishop's Cross to Carolyn Peterson, member of Church of the Incarnation, Salina and Chair of the Bishop Search Committee; The Rev. Jerry Jones, president of the Standing Committee for two years during the bishop search; Harry Smith, member of Christ Cathedral and Toni Cottrell, diocesan administrator. Congratulations to all the recipients.

#### Second Legislative Session Saturday, October 20, 2018

We reconvened at 9: 15 am on Saturday for our second business session. Chair of Credentials announced a quorum was present in each order; 25 of 36 in clerical order, and 41 of 57 in the lay order.

DeMay Grunden, the third presenter on Project Resource spoke to us on "Scarcity to Abundance" the power of saying yes; changing our narrative from scarcity to abundance. Grunden introduced herself as a married mom, husband is an attorney, they have two young children and she serves as a licensed therapist for the non-profit Ashby House in Salina. She spoke about the Theology of giving; Exodus 3:4-7 "I give much, because I have been given much." Why do we exist? We welcome all, because we all need Jesus and we are always open and welcoming.

The 2019 Budget was present for approval. Motion made, seconded and passed without dissent.

The assessment rate for the diocese will remain at 150/0. Motion made, seconded and passed without dissent.

#### **STANDING COMMITTEE REPORT**

The work of the current Standing Committee for 2018 really began in 2017 following the Diocesan Convention with the extending of the terms of office by one year. This allowed the members of the committee to see to its conclusion the process of the election of the next bishop of our diocese.

The first item on the agenda was an online video conference with The Rt. Rev. Clay Matthews from the office of Pastoral Development of the House of Bishops. Bishop Matthews outlined the process and the necessary procedures involved in the search for and the election of our next bishop.

That process included: 1. A time-line for necessary tasks. 2. The selection of a Search Committee. 3. The development of a Diocesan Profile. 4. The discernment by the Search Committee of clergy nominees regarding their qualifications for the position of bishop. 5. The selection of candidates to be presented of for consideration for election. 6. The "Walk About" meeting sites. 7. The election of our next bishop. It was a long and very involved process that was accomplished by the hard work of the Search Committee with over-sight by the Standing Committee.

The Standing Committee met the required 4 times with additional meetings involving the search process and election. We gave consent to the election of 6 Bishops and affirmed the ordination of new clergy in our own diocese.

#### **ENDOWMENT FUND TRUSTEES' REPORT**

The 2017 investment performance of the Endowment was excellent, gaining 22% on invested assets. The investment income for the year of \$752,937 was an increase of 34% over 2016. Twelve of the thirteen securities owned at year end gained market value. The trustees sold all the owned shares of IBM, Kroger and Suncor. Contributions were received in 2017 from Sherry Denton for Incarnation, Mark Cowell for the Larned Pilgrimage, St. Paul's for youth scholarships and from Ashby House. St. Thomas Garden City contributed \$100,000 in 2018. The Endowment 2017 distributions were - \$154,000 to the Diocese, \$33,000 to Ashby House, \$30,000 to St. Anne's, \$6,000 to Holy Apostles, \$3,500 to Incarnation, \$2,500 to St Elizabeth's and \$2,343 to St Mark's. The 2017 investment gain was allocated proportionally among 25 funds based on the 2017 average balance for each. Donor Restricted gifts are perpetual, indexed to investment performance and only the earnings are available for spending. So, the Trustees deduct five percent of the average of the most recent three years' balance for each Restricted Fund and transfer it to the corresponding Spendable Fund. This provided \$108,585 new money for use by these beneficiaries in future years. These spendable funds totaled \$629,192 for 2017.

Managed Funds may be withdrawn in part or in total by the donor. Partial withdrawals are permitted upon the request of the donor or on a regularly scheduled monthly or quarterly basis. Withdrawals of entire fund balances may be made with at least 30 days' written notice to the trustees.

Council Restricted Funds may be withdrawn by the Diocese, subject to these guidelines:

The Future Ministry Opportunity Fund balance is \$310,473 and is to be used at the discretion of the Bishop and Council

The Lambeth Fund balance is \$27,027 and is to be used to help fund the Bishop's travel expenses to the Lambeth Conference.

The Standing Committee Fund balance is \$3,066 and is to be used at the discretion of the Bishop and Council Copies of complete financial statements for the Endowment are available by contacting Toni Cottrell at the Diocese office.

#### YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRIES

This past March, St. Cornelius, Dodge City, and Sts. Mary and Martha, Larned, sent youth on a pilgrimage to Canterbury Cathedral in the UK. Youth Convention was again held at Camp WaJaTo in Lyons Kansas. About 21 youth attended. Ethan Newberry and Hunter Barker are the youth delegates to this convention. Randall Thornton is the alternate. The theme for Youth Convention this year was "Putting on the Armor of God". The youth explored how to protect and equip themselves for life in society. The audited assets and liabilities of the Endowment Fund represent balances as of December 31, 2017. The audited Endowment Fund statement of assets, liabilities and fund balances are incorporated into the financial statement of the Diocese of Western Kansas at year end and will appear in the 2017 Journal of the Diocese of Western Kansas.
